

30 DAY PRAYER CHALLENGE

Do you have what it takes to do this?

YES! YOU DO!

Week 1: “Delight yourself in the Lord” Psalm 37:4

Day 1	Psalm 119:33-37 – Reflect on this	Pray that God will direct you in His paths.
Day 2	Consider Isaiah 48:17	Pray for God's very “best” for you.
Day 3	Read Galations 5:22-25	Ask God for the desire to keep in step with His Spirit.
Day 4	Look at Haggai 1:13-15	“Lord, please come and stir our spirits today.”
Day 5	See Matthew 18:1-5	Become like a child as you pray, full of wonder.
Day 6	Check out I Timothy 6:17-19	Thank Him for providing everything for our enjoyment and for the life that is truly life!
Day 7	Read Philippians 1:3-11, focusing on Paul's prayer in verses 9-11	Make this prayer personal by changing the “your” to “my” and the “you” to “I”.

For “extra credit”...

Everyday

- Reread Psalm 37:3-6 and Psalm 37:23-24
- Read Ephesians 6:19-20 – pray this prayer for Pastor Kip
- Pray for our president and our country
- Pray for the elderly in your family and in your community

30 DAY PRAYER CHALLENGE

YES! You still have what it takes to keep going!

Week 2: Cultivate your soil – Matthew 13:3-9

Day 1	Reflect on Hosea 10:12	Ask the Lord for discernment as you “break up the unplowed ground” in your life.
Day 2	Think about Matthew 5:3-12	“Lord, mold me and shape me until I get to this place of 'blessed.'”
Day 3	Read Deuteronomy 8:1-20, focusing on verses 10-15	“Lord, test me always and cultivate a humble spirit within me.”
Day 4	Consider Colossians 3:1-17	Pray that God will clothe you with His virtues, especially love.
Day 5	Look at II Corinthians 4:7-18	Ask that God will cultivate a steadfast spirit within you to not lose heart and ask Him to renew you inwardly, everyday.
Day 6	Read Matthew 13:3-9	“Oh God, help me to see my need for good soil.”
Day 7	Read Matthew 13:18-23	Ask God for wisdom to hear and understand His Word.

For “extra credit”...

Everyday

- Read Romans 12:9-18 – pray these things for our church
- Pray for our schools and our teachers and leaders
- Pray for unity in our churches, homes and community

30 DAY PRAYER CHALLENGE

You're on a roll – keep it going!

Week 3: Confession – Psalm 32:1-7

Day 1	Reflect on Psalm 32:1-7, focusing on verse 5	Pray that you will recognize your sin and your need to confess it and be forgiven.
Day 2	Look at Lamentations 3:37-40	Test and examine your life and ask the Lord to reveal anything that needs confessing.
Day 3	Consider I John 2:15-17	“Lord, forgive me for loving the things of this world and help me to do Your will.
Day 4	Read Hosea 10:12-13	Confess to the Lord that you've tried doing things with your own strength.
Day 5	Think about Malachi 3:6-12 and James 4:8	Apologize to God for turning away from Him. Return to Him and draw near to Him.
Day 6	See Matthew 19:16-30	“Jesus, forgive me for holding onto things too tightly.”
Day 7	Read Philippians 2:3-11, focusing on verses 3 & 4	Confess your selfish ambition and vain conceit and ask Him to help you consider others better than yourself.

For “extra credit”...

Everyday

- Read Matthew 7:7-8 pray these three things with confidence!
- Pray for Pastor Mark and our HP Youth Fellowship
- Pray for our neighbors, next door and up and down the street

30 DAY PRAYER CHALLENGE

You're doing well – hasn't this been good?

Week 4: The prayer of Jesus. Matthew 6:9-13

Day 1	“Our Father in Heaven, hallowed be Your Name.”	Pray with a reverent attitude toward our Father.
Day 2	“Your Kingdom come.”	Pray with a selfless motive - “It's all about You, Lord.”
Day 3	“Your will be done on earth as it is in Heaven.”	Pray with a yielded spirit for God's will in your life.
Day 4	“Give us this day, our daily bread.”	Pray this reasonable request for your daily needs.
Day 5	“Forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.”	Pray with a humble heart and a contrite spirit.
Day 6	“And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.”	Declare your <i>dependence</i> on His leadership.
Day 7	“For Yours is the Kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen!”	Pray for an unshakable faith in God's Kingdom and in His power and glory.

For “extra credit”...

Everyday

- Read Psalm 19:14 – pray this for yourself
- Pray for the pastors and churches in our community
- Pray for a deep desire to know and follow hard after God
- Now that you've done this for 30 days, pray that you would keep in His Word and prayer!
